## ANTICA NAMUR, BETTER AND BETTER!

From 10 till 18 November 2018

Every autumn, Antica Namur reinforces its status of the « place to be » for the world of art and antiques. As it is the first fair in the autumn, Antica Namur functions as one of the first barometers of the Belgian art market of the year. This edition was already sold out by the exhibitors from the spring of 2018 onwards. The organisers of this 43th edition have chosen to use the second hall of Namur Expo as well, which hasn't received exhibitors since 2010.

This XX edition unites a total of 130 Belgian and international galleries or +12% compared to the 2017 edition, including more than 80 Belgian galleries, 31 French galleries, 10 from the Netherlands and 5 from Germany. Amongst the international exhibitors, there are also English, Swiss, Luxembourg and Italian galleries. The total surface of the fair went from 8.000 to 10.000 m<sup>2</sup>.
